HERS RATER

Inspects and audits homes according to the Home Energy Rating System (HERS) to determine how energy efficient the house is.



ENERGY MODELER

Uses specialized software to create virtual models of buildings or systems to analyze and predict their energy consumption.



RATING FIELD INSPECTOR

Conducts on-site home inspections, under the supervision of a certified Home Energy Rater, to gather data needed to produce a home energy rating.
